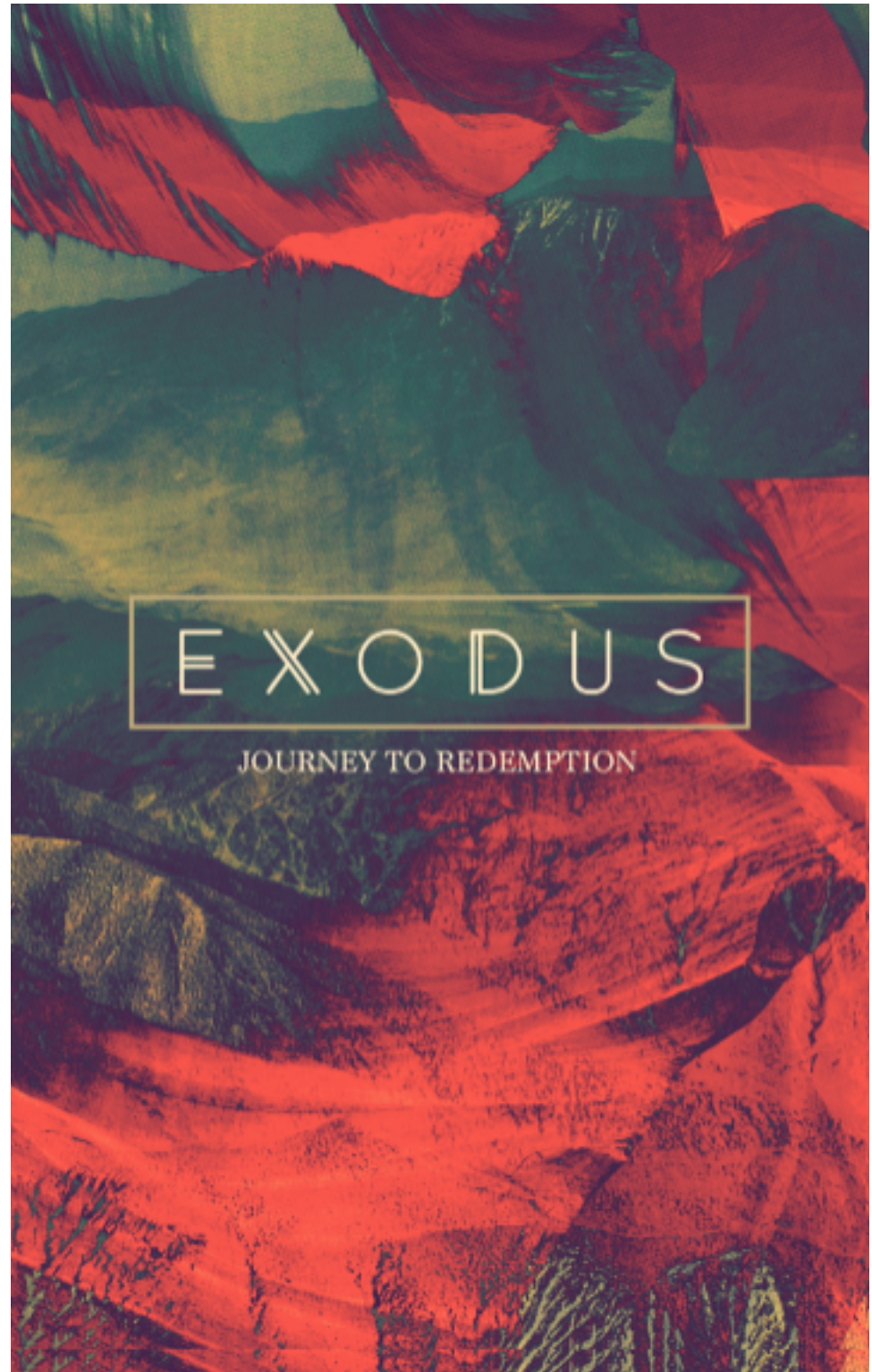

CHINA

China's Communist government has banned the online sale of Bibles in a further attempt to silence the witness of persecuted Christians. The Chinese Communist Party is also finalizing a revised study Bible that includes notes teaching its Communist ideology.

IRAQ

In 2014, when ISIS invaded Mosul and surrounding areas of the Nineveh Plains, where Iraqi Christians have lived for generations, the Islamists systematically burned churches and Bibles. Now, Christians there are hungry to once again own a copy of God's Word.
